

2017 JURIES

PRIX ITALIA REGULATIONS – ART. 10 - JURIES

The juries are composed of qualified persons appointed by the organisations and chosen from among experts in the respective genres. Jury members should have a good command of at least the English language and should be instructed by the Secretariat to read Art. 10.1 of the Regulations (Working procedures). The choice of organisations, which are represented in each jury, is based on a rotation system so as to allow the widest possible participation in the composition of the juries. In every edition of the Prix, each organisation should appoint a representative in the jury to which it has been assigned. The jurors must not be directly involved in the production of the programmes and projects submitted to the competition by the Organisation they represent. The travel and accommodation expenses incurred by the jury members, as for all other delegates, are paid by the organisations they represent.
